Receive free training to become an IRS-certified tax preparer - then volunteer a few hours per month to prepare taxes for those unable to afford it.

Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA), part of Self Help, Inc. free income tax preparation Project, offers free tax preparation at sites throughout the tax season from January to April each year.

This fast and free service helps residents avoid predatory income-tax preparers and costly refund-anticipation loans.

VITA volunteers work to ensure that eligible families take advantage of the Earned Income Tax Credit (EITC), which can increase a family's annual income up to 15 percent.

Volunteering with VITA is fun, easy, and rewarding.

You do not need to be an accountant or have a finance background to participate. Choice of online and live class training is available. Bilingual speaking volunteers greatly needed.

Site Coordinator: Manage site operations and supervise the Tax Preparers volunteering at that site
